



Format a Bibliography

Remember:

- Alphabetize your list by the first word of the citation (unless it's A, An, or The).
- Cite the sources of pictures as well as facts.
- Indent after the first line of a citation (see examples below.).
- Single space each citation; leave one blank line between citations.
- Put two spaces after a period or colon; one space after a comma or other punctuation.

Book by one author

Format	Last name, First name. <i>Title of book</i> . Place of publication: Publisher, copyright year.
Example	Campbell, Lily. <i>Shakespeare's Tragic Heroes</i> . New York: Cambridge University Press, 1930.

Book by two authors

Format	Last name, First name. <i>Title of book</i> . Place of publication: Publisher, copyright year.
Example	Peach, Susan and Anne Millard. <i>The Greeks</i> . London: Usborne Publishing, 1990.

Book by three or more authors

Format	Last name, First name et al. <i>Title of book</i> . Place of publication: Publisher, copyright year.
Example	Armento, Beverly et al. <i>A Message of Ancient Days</i> . Boston: Houghton Mifflin Co., 1999.

Book by an editor

Format	Last name, First name, ed. <i>Title of book</i> . Place of publication: Publisher, copyright year.
Example	Carey, John, ed. <i>Eyewitness to History</i> . New York: Avon Books, 1987.

Personal Interview

Format Last name, First name. Personal interview. Day month year of interview.

Example Morrison, Toni. Personal interview. 1 April 2004.

Encyclopedia

Format "Title of article." *Name of encyclopedia*. Copyright year of edition. Pages used.

Example "Massachusetts." *The Columbia Encyclopedia*. 1950 ed. 1237-1239.

Magazine or newspaper article in print

Format Last name, First name. "Title of article." *Name of magazine or newspaper*. Day month year of publication: page numbers.

Example Hoy, Cyrus. "New Questions about Shakespeare's Texts." *New York Times*. 25 May 1994: 23.

Web site with an author

Format Last name, First name. "Title of web page." *Name of web site*. Day month year of use. <URL>

Example Kinnaer, Jacques. "The Language of Ancient Egypt." *The Ancient Egypt Site*. 13 July 2002. <<http://www.geocities.com/~amenhotep/language/index.html>>

Web site without an author

Format "Title of web page." *Name of web site*. Day month year of use. <URL>

Example "Apartheid." *Africana.com*. 13 July 2002. <<http://www.africana.com/>>

Article from online database

Format Last name, First name. "Title of article." *Title of periodical*. Publication date (day month year). Day month year of use. <URL>

Example Farley, Christopher John. "Aretha Franklin: The Soul Musician." *Time*. 8 June 1998. 26 July 2001. <infotrac.galegroup.com>
