Working Group Charge and Goals

- ▶ Define what are the necessary changes to make a later high school start time happen in Newton
- ▶ Gain a full understanding of the action steps, resources and changes that are necessary in the short- and long-term



Working Group Charge and Goals cont.

- ▶ Determine how can meaningful progress can be made
 - ▶ Formulate action steps, resources and changes into a detailed **road map**
 - ▶ Road map will reference cost information and other necessary resources, as well as policy and legal implications
