ART COURSES

- 708 Art Major 1 - FY
A great course for students for whom 'Art' is a significant focus in their life
- 701 Art Minor 1 - SEM
A great course for students for who love 'Art' but want added flexibility in their schedule
- 715 Photography Minor 1 - Q
The first course in Photography - exposure to both digital and analog (darkroom) photography
- 705 Ceramics Minor 1 - SEM
A wonderful opportunity for students who may not consider themselves 'artists,' but then realize - they are!
- 70121 Animation - Q
An exciting new course exploring the world of Animation

MUSIC COURSES

- 801 Vocal Ensemble - SEM
The beginning of the choral program at North (freshman choir) - also will have the opportunity to perform alongside the other groups
- Note – Family Singers (FY), Jubilee Singers (FY) and Concert Choir (SEM) are all non-auditioned for the '21-'22 school year (10•11•12)*
- 805 Symphony Orchestra - FY
A wonderful opportunity for students who wish to perform with an Orchestra - violin, viola, cello, bass - unlike in the past, this course is fully in the school day
- 808 Symphonic Band – SEM (with the opportunity to add an additional term of study)
The beginning of the band program at North – a great place to grow musically and make friends
- 833 Jazz Workshop - SEM
The place for students who want to explore the world of jazz / funk
- 831 Rock Workshop - SEM
A great opportunity for students interested in Rock Music performance
- 812 Music Theory - SEM

The first level of our 'theory' sequence - important for all musicians regardless of genre / past education

- 813 AP Music Theory - FY
The only AP available to freshman...not easy; rare cases, but terrific class (for most Music Theory is an important precursor)
- 814 Music Technology - Q
This is a great, creative class for musicians and non-musicians alike - the music lab is equipped with Logic Pro X
- 815 Film Scoring - SEM
Great for students who enjoy music and movies - opportunities to score films and learn about the inner workings of movie making
- 816 History of Rock Music - Q
A class for students who enjoy music and want to learn about rock & pop music
- 819 Music of the Beatles - Q
It is focused on the Beatles and their music, but similar to the History of Rock class - accessible and a nice entry spot into music
- 8382 American Musical Theatre - Q
For students who enjoy musical theatre and want to learn more about the history and progression of drama in the United States over the last 100 years

- 820 Acting 1 - SEM
The first class for students interested in learning to act / stage performance - wonderful opportunity for all students / confidence builder
- 822 Introduction to Technical Theatre - Q
A great class for students interested in learning about all aspects of 'backstage' - set design, building, lighting, sound, etc.
- 836 Costume, Hair and Makeup Design 1 - Q
A great class for students interested in learning about all aspects of costuming, make-up, and design
- 823 Tech Theatre Production Design - After School
A wonderful opportunity for students to work on shows within a kind and hardworking community
