These are important decisions that require collaboration between you, your child, and the school. In the next few months students will be learning about the NNHS 9th grade opportunities from their teachers, guidance counselor, and NNHS students and staff.

Students will be receiving a NNHS course catalogue on March 4th. The catalogue contains information about the high school programs and course descriptions.
