

**Please have all items in school by the FIRST FRIDAY of the school year.**

*On the first day of school you will only need a folder and a pencil!*

We strongly encourage re-use throughout the year, so consider sending in supplies you already have rather than purchasing new ones.

**Required items for individual use (please put your name on these):**

- LOTS of pencils with erasers (you can not have too many pencils)
- one 3” 3-ring binder for *everyday* use, so STURDY and DURABLE (Staples: “Better 3 inch D 3 Ring View Binder”)
- one 3” 3-ring binder for completed work portfolio (stays in school, economy style is fine)
- 10 dividers for your binders, with label tabs
- lined loose-leaf binder paper (keep part of your supply at home to resupply)
- one lined composition book (bound marbled notebook)
- TWO durable 2-pocket folders for carrying in a binder. Staples: “2 Pocket Folder, Snap In 3-Hole Punched”. These are for frequent use– we recommend that these be poly/plastic.
- one spiral graph paper notebook
- manual pencil sharpener
- highlighter(s)
- earbuds or inexpensive headphones to keep at school (label with your name)

**Required Items for SHARED CLASSROOM use.** *Please do NOT label these items with your name.*

- one roll of clear tape (“Scotch”, not packing)
- plastic ruler with metric measurement (shared)
- glue sticks
- two ultra-fine or fine-point Sharpies, preferably black
- at least one pad of sticky notes (Post-its, or other) – preferably 3”x 3”
- two (or so) red ball-point pens *The simple “stick” kind are best and cheapest.*

**Requested/OPTIONAL items:**

- scissors for shared classroom use
- markers to contribute to the class’ supply
- a sturdy, reusable personal water bottle to keep at your desk. Please put your name on the bottle.
- pencil case (one that goes into a binder is the most useful)
- duct tape (for communal use)
