Registration/Sign Up: Families must register all student athletes and enter basic contact and medical information on the [FamilyID](#) site for our school. Registration through Family ID will be only open from 8:00 AM on Friday March 6 and close at 8:00 PM on Monday, March 23. Please register during that time frame; there will not be extensions to the registration period because we anticipate many students trying out and team rosters to be filled.

Each participant must be registered before participating in concussion testing and tryouts. So if you know that your child would like to tryout, don't wait, register now!

- Tryouts will be the Week of March 30
- Track Tryouts will begin on Thursday, March 26
- Concussion Testing will be done by each sport after school between March 25-27. Each coach will inform their players when to attend
- **Please understand that students will not be allowed to attend a try out until your family has registered through [FamilyID](#), had concussion testing at school and submitted an up-to-date physical.**

Physical Documentation: All students participating in after-school sports are required to bring a copy of their most recent physical exam prior to the start of the sports season which includes tryouts and practices. *"A physical exam covers the student for 13 months from the exam date.*

*A student's eligibility will terminate once a physical has reached the 13 month limit." (Taken from MIAA Regulations 56.1). A hard copy of a completed physical must be turned in by **Wednesday, March 25** to School Nurse Riley.*

Fee Payment: All fee payments are due no later than **Friday, April 17** and can be made through the [City of Newton fee payment system \(UniPay Gold\)](#). Please email the UniPay confirmation of payment to russell_hunt@newton.k12.ma.us If necessary, families may still pay by the \$180 user fee by check made payable to City of Newton. Checks may be submitted to Mr. Russell Hunt, the Oak Hill Afterschool Enrichment and Athletics Manager. Families may also request financial assistance, also known as a fee waiver, using the form posted on [FamilyID](#). Information for fee waivers is also available [here](#).
