

Newton North High School Student Parking Regulations 2019-2020

Duration – These regulations take effect one week before and after the regular school year for students and will be enforced from 7:30 a.m. through 4:00 p.m. every day classes are in session.

Student Parking Permits – Student parking permits will be issued by the Newton Police Department and applications must be postmarked no later than August 15. There is a \$25 fee payable by check to the City of Newton due at the time of application.

You must mail the completed and signed application along with copies of your valid driver's license and registration as well as a self-addressed stamped envelope. If you do not receive a parking permit your payment and forms will be returned in the envelope you provide. A parking permit allows you to legally park in a designated area, it does not guarantee you a space. Any issues regarding parking violations or the inability to park should be directed to the Newton Police. A student's parking permit can be revoked by either the Newton Police or NNHS administration if the student violates parking regulations.
